


• born in 1896 in Kolin on the Labe, died in 1976 in Prague


Jan Sudek

- respected for poetic, romantic, deep emotions and crystal-clearness in his art.

































- born in 1883 in Příbram, died in 1961 in Prague, as a photographer totally forgotten

- then he started painting and studying eastern philosophy



























Jan Reich

- a lot of photos without people








